


CASE STUDY: PHARMACEUTICAL PACKAGING FORM

- ❖ This bar coded form is used by a pharmaceutical manufacturer to maintain the highest possible level of quality control as its products are shipped to customers.
- ❖ When a customer places an order, packaging instructions are printed on the form. It takes a number of individuals to ship the order. As the various functions—such as labeling, proper sealing and accurate weighing—are completed, that information is recorded.
- ❖ As the information is recorded, the individual in charge of the function scans both the bar coded form and his or her badge number.
- ❖ The bar coded form makes it possible to maintain a high degree of accuracy and quality control, which are essential for a pharmaceutical manufacturer.
